



Official Voters Lists Lloydminster By-Election

The Official Voters List can be picked up by authorized individuals on Sunday, November 9. A paper copy of the list can be picked up at the Returning Office in Lloydminster while an electronic copy can be picked up from the Elections Saskatchewan Head Office in Regina.

Detailed instructions are below:

1. **Acquiring a Paper Copy of the Official Voters List:** A paper copy of the Official Voters List will be available at the Advance Poll in Lloydminster on Sunday, November 9 starting at 2 p.m. Central Time (1 p.m. Mountain Time) and ending at 7 p.m. Central Time (and 6 p.m. Mountain Time) from Ms. Carol Dodsworth. The Advance Poll in Lloydminster is located at 4417 50th Avenue (please follow the signs to the back entrance).

The paper copy of the Official Voters List can **only be picked up by**:

- A nominated candidate;
- A business manager; or
- The Chief Official Agent for the party.

The person picking up the list will be required to provide ID to prove their identity and to sign Elections Saskatchewan form E-293. Form E-293 is a declaration made to protect the data contained on the Official Voters List. Please note that by signing form E-293 the person is also agreeing to provide Elections Saskatchewan with an executed Form E-295 (Declaration to Secure the List of Electors). Both forms are attached to this memo.

The voters list will also be available for pickup at the Returning Office during regular office hours on November 10 and November 12 using the same processes as described above.

2. **Acquiring an Electronic Copy of the Official Voters List:** An electronic copy of the list will be available at Elections Saskatchewan Head Office (1702 Park Street, Regina) between 3 and 4 pm Central Time (2 and 3 pm Mountain Time) on Sunday, November 9.

The electronic copy of the Official Voters List can **only be picked up by** either:

- A nominated candidate;
- A business manager;
- The Chief Official Agent for the party; or
- An authorized representative of the Chief Official Agent as identified in advance. If this fourth option is being pursued, please inform Mr. Jeff Kress, Deputy Chief Electoral Officer, Operations, by phone at 306.529.0893 or by e-mail (jkress@elections.sk.ca) of the name of individual representatives authorized to pick up the list on behalf to the Chief Official Agent.

The person picking up the electronic copy of the Official Voters list will be required to sign form E-293 and provide identification consistent with the processes noted above.
