AUDITORS' REPORT

To: **Wayne Welte, Business Manager of Sarah Connor, Candidate in the Election in the constituency of Kindersley.**

We have audited the return of election expenses of Sarah Connor, Candidate in the election in the constituency of Kindersley, for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on our audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, we conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the business manager, as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of *The Election Act, 1996* to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007.

We further report that contributions received by the campaign total \$28,447.02 and expenses total \$28,039.05 and Candidate expenses paid the campaign total \$1,054.54 (included in expenses total).

Revenue received by a candidate from fund-raising activities, meetings and sales of material of a promotional nature are deemed contributions. The total net proceeds from each source indicated must be recorded and, in the aggregate, reported in this Return.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
