## AUDITOR'S REPORT



To Robert Unchulenko,

Business Manager for Bob Bjornerud, a candidate in the election of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, held on the 7th day of November 2007 in the Constituency of Melville-Saltcoats.

We have audited the Return of Candidate's Election Expenses, in respect of the above candidacy of Bob Bjornerud. This financial information is the responsibility of the candidate's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial information based on our audit.

We have conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial information is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial information. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial information.

In common with other candidacies, it is not possible to determine by auditing procedures the extent of omissions, if any, from the accounting records related to this candidacy. Therefore our examination of the financial transactions was directed to transactions recorded in the accounting records.

In our opinion the Return of Candidate's Election Expenses of Bob Bjornerud presents fairly in all material respects, the financial transactions required by Section 261 of the Election Act to be detailed in the Return.
