AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: Don Matthes, Business Manager of Marie-France Magnin

I have audited the return of election expenses of Marie-France Magnin for the campaign period from October 10 to November 11, 2007. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the business manager, as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments may be necessary to those expenses.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I might have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material aspects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of the *Election Act, 1996* to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10 to November 11, 2007.

Although all payments of election expenses to creditors have been made, proof of payments for all expenses in the form of cancelled cheques is not available until February 15, 2008 at which time the bank statement for the period ending January 31, 2008 is expected to be received. As the Candidate's Return of Election Expenses is due for submission by February 8, 2008 it is understood that the Return is submitted prior to receipt of the bank statement and therefore verification of these payments is pending the receipt of this bank statement.

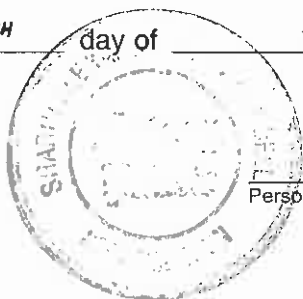
