## AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: **Dwayne Braun, Business Manager of Jonathan, Saskatchewan Party  
Candidate, Saskatoon Centre.**


I have audited the return of election expenses of Jonathan Abrametz for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the business manager as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I might have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of *The Election Act*, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007.

A "**Schedule of Adjustments**" is attached which lists changes I determined to be necessary, clarification of certain items and comments on certain items.

**Jonathan Abrametz: Schedule of Adjustments November 7, 2007 Election  
(Saskatchewan Party Candidate - Saskatoon Centre)**

1. There is a discrepancy of \$642.50 between total donations reported and amounts deposited into the bank account. This amount could be either understated amount from donors or understated gross proceeds from a fundraising event held during the writ period. The final result is Total Contributions should be increased by \$642.50.
2. In addition, there was an unreported contribution from the Saskatoon Constituency Association in the amount of \$157.80 and Saskatchewan Party Fund Inc. in the amount of \$265.63 (this was an individual donation made directly to Saskatchewan Party Head Office).
3. An audit of the fundraising event held during the writ period was not possible. However, audit checks were performed to ensure costs of the fundraiser were not included as eligible election expenses.
4. There were discrepancies between amounts paid and claimed as follows:  
*Services:* Shaw Cable claimed \$647.28; 2 cancelled cheques \$509.78  
*Services:* Canada Post claimed \$630.48; no cancelled cheque since apparently paid on February 1, 2008.  
*Goods Supplied:* Saskatoon Fastprint claimed \$2,408.70; cancelled cheque \$2,132.32  
*Goods Supplied:* Werezak's claimed \$421.12; 3 cancelled cheques \$421.12 but one receipt for \$126.78 is unavailable.  
*Goods Supplied:* Staples Business Depot claimed \$170.62 and Superstore claimed \$22.16 apparently reimbursed part of cheque #36 which was unavailable.
5. Bank service charges and cheque printing costs were unclaimed; this amounted \$132.8.
6. There was an expenses claim to Saskatoon Portable Signs that was pre-writ and a significant portion of the *Undisputed Claims Unpaid* to Merchant Law Group is outside the writ period.

Revenue received by a candidate from fund-raising activities, meetings and sales of material of a promotional nature are deemed contributions. The total net proceeds from each source indicated must be recorded and, in the aggregate, reported in this Return.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
