AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: **Rodney Trayhorne, Business Manager of Terry Alm, Saskatchewan Party Candidate, Saskatoon Eastview.**


I have audited the return of election expenses of Terry Alm for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the business manager as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I might have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of *The Election Act*, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007.

A "**Schedule of Adjustments**" is attached which lists changes I determined to be necessary, clarification of certain items and comments on certain items.

**Terry Alm: Schedule of Adjustments November 7, 2007 Election
(Saskatchewan Party Candidate - Saskatoon Eastview)**

1. There was \$2,054.67 of expenses paid by the Saskatoon Eastview Constituency Association. This amount was not shown as a contribution and related *Statement of Contribution* was not completed.
2. Loan documentation was not available but the amount of interest paid (\$94.52) appears reasonable for the amount and duration of loan.
3. *Hire of Premises* has \$750.48 from Saskatoon Golf and Country which appears to be food for workers on November 7, 2007. Therefore, this amount in the wrong classification.
4. The amount for *Hire of Premises* of \$2,544.00 is for October and November per invoice which exceeds the writ period. This could be that no rental spaces were available for partial months but this was not verified.
5. Item 11b under *Petty Expenses* appears to include pre-writ expenses.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.



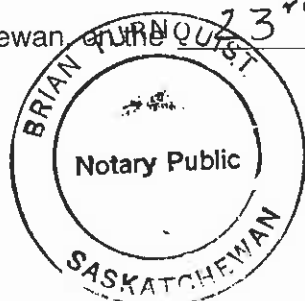


