#### **AUDITOR'S REPORT**

To: Curtis Kimpton, Business Manager of Ron Norris, Saskatchewan Party CATCHEW

I have audited the return of election expenses of Rob Norris for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the business manager as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I might have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of *The Election Act*, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007.

A "Schedule of Adjustments" is attached which lists changes I determined to be necessary, clarification of certain items and comments on certain items.

#### Rob Norris: Schedule of Adjustments November 7, 2007 Election Candidate (Saskatoon Greystone)

- 1. Total contributions are understated. There was a fundraising event that netted proceeds of \$1,690.61 during the writ period. Also payment of \$2,832.65 to compensate the campaign manager was made by a third party, namely Sirron Ltd. (a Service Agreement instead of a Donor's Statement was signed by Sirron Ltd.)

  Therefore, total contributions would increase by \$4,523.26.
- 2. There appears to be some expenses that are outside the writ period, specifically *Petty Expense* of \$100.24. The Election deposit plus cost of money order was incorrectly claimed. The amount to Sheaf Publishing under *Advertising* is underclaimed by \$225.01.
- 3. The amounts claimed under *Travel and Hire of Vehicle* are for privately owned vehicles without reference to distance traveled or specific paid bills. In fact, there was no amount paid but only a commercial rental value was provided.
- 4. There are claims for printed material that were bought several months pre-writ and no allocation was made for consumption of any material pre-writ. Also, there to be no allocation of other expenses as to writ-period and outside writ period.
- 5. Some cancelled cheques were unavailable for audit since they were as of date audit not returned from the bank. Many expenses were personally paid by the Business Manager who then was later reimbursed by the campaign.

- 3. The commercial value of goods and services donated (other than volunteer labour or goods valued at \$200.00 or less), and the difference between the amount paid and the commercial value of goods and services provided, are considered to be election expenses. If the total of "commercial value" is greater than the total of "amount paid" it is the larger of the two figures that is used in the calculation of election expenses incurred by the candidate. See definition of "commercial value", subsection 220(c).
- 4. A statement, signed and receipted, by the donor and by the business manager, supported by a verification from an independent commercial source of the amount expensed must be submitted when making claim of commercial value as an election expense.

5. All payments of more than \$25.00 must be accompanied by a supplier document that states the particulars of the election expense and by a receipt or cancelled cheque that provides proof of payment. The supplier documents and proofs of payment must be submitted with this Return.

Further, if the candidate dies or withdraws before appointing a business manager, the candidate's estate or the candidate shall pay the excess amount in accordance with the above.

Contributions include money provided to or on behalf of the candidate without compensation from the candidate and includes donations in kind.

Detail of the name of and total amount received from each contributor included in classes 1 to 5 in Part (a) who have provided money, goods or services by way of a gift, loan, advance, deposit or other form of assistance must be reported in the aggregate by classification in the appropriate schedule. Such contributions are to be identified in one of three categories: (A) contributions in excess of \$250.00, (B) contributions of \$250.00 or less but more than \$25.00, and (C) contributions of \$25.00 or less. The sum of the categories should reflect the total contributions received for the use of the candidate in each classification schedule.

Where a corporation, trust fund or constituency association makes a contribution, pursuant to subsection 240(6) of *The Election Act*, 1996, each such contribution must be accompanied by a statement which sets out the name of the person who authorized the contribution on behalf of the corporation, trust fund or constituency association, and the name of and the amount contributed by, each person who made a contribution in excess of \$250.00 in a year and whose contribution was used to make up the funds contributed by the corporation, trust fund or constituency association.

Where a registered party makes a contribution, pursuant to subsection 240(7) of *The Election Act, 1996*, each such contribution must be accompanied by a statement which sets out the name of and the amount contributed by, each person who made a contribution in excess of \$250.00 in a year and whose contribution was used to make up the funds contributed by the registered party.

A true and correct copy, certified by the business manager, for each such statement of contribution received pursuant to subsections 240(6) and (7), must be affixed to this Return (ss. 261(3)).

Revenue received by a candidate from fund-raising activities, meetings and sales of material of a promotional nature are deemed contributions. The total net proceeds from each source indicated must be recorded and, in the aggregate, reported in this Return.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
