AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: **Ivan Bergerman, Business Manager of Dennis Neudorf, Saskatchewan Party Candidate, Saskatoon Massey Place.**


I have audited the return of election expenses of Dennis Neudorf for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the business manager as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I might have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of *The Election Act*, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007.

A "**Schedule of Adjustments**" is attached which lists changes I determined to be necessary, clarification of certain items and comments on certain items.

**Dennis Neudorf: Schedule of Adjustments November 7, 2007 Election
(Saskatchewan Party Candidate - Saskatoon Massey Place)**

1. There was no claim for expected interest expense as per loan agreements. These loans were directly used to finance the campaign. The amounts are 0.60 on overdraft interest on the bank account plus approximately \$250.00 on the \$15,000.00 loan plus approximately \$200.00 on the \$10,000.00 loan.
2. There was a donation indicated from Novatex Graphics \$485.63 which should be claimed as an eligible election expense in the same amount. It is my understanding this invoice was to be paid by a third party (at this time there is no supporting documentation to support this claim i.e. Donor's Statement).
3. The invoice/receipt for *Hire of Premises* does not have sufficient detail as to the time period involved.
4. There was an amount of \$10,000.00 claimed as advertising to the Saskatchewan Party Fund Inc. when the invoice indicates \$8,000.00 was advertising and \$2,000.00 was for polling.
5. No Joint Agreement for \$1,000.00 claim as billboard advertising item #5 under Goods Supplies.
6. It appears that some portion of *Goods Supplied* claim with respect to purchases from Saskatoon Fastprint Ltd. and CBS Outdoor were for goods consumed pre-writ.
7. The WBM Office Systems Donor's Statement for donations in kind has insufficient detail as to exact nature of the expense.
8. There is no documentation for likely donations-in-kind with respect to computer usage and internet services.
9. There were immaterial amounts where payments did not correspond to the invoice and the lower amount was claimed (CFRC 90.5 and Beagle Productions).

4. A statement, signed and receipted, by the donor and by the business manager, supported by a verification from an independent commercial source of the amount expensed must be submitted when making claim of commercial value as an election expense.


