## AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: **Rudolph Lambert, Business Manager of Fred Ozirney, Saskatchewan Party Candidate, Saskatoon Riversdale.**



I have audited the return of election expenses of Fred Ozirney for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the business manager as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I might have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of *The Election Act*, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007.

A "**Schedule of Adjustments**" is attached which lists changes I determined to be necessary, clarification of certain items and comments on certain items.

**November 7, 2007 Election Candidate (Saskatoon Riversdale)**



1. Contributions from Saskatoon Riversdale Constituency Association appear to total \$20,600.00 as evidenced by deposits into the campaign bank account (of which \$5,000.00 was several months before writ period). There were deposits totaling \$1,965.63 from the Saskatchewan Party Fund Inc. which are not specifically identified on the Election Return. It is presumed these deposits were from donors that were routed through Saskatchewan Party Head Office for political tax credit purposes.
2. *Statement of Contribution Constituency Association* from Saskatoon Riversdale will have to be corrected.
3. There likely may be differing interpretations as to whether certain items were improperly excluded as election expenses and other items improperly included as election expenses. It is beyond the scope of this audit to make those determinations but rather the Chief Electoral Officer of Saskatchewan will make them.


