AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: **Marlin Stangeland, Business Manager of Ken Cheveldayoff, Saskatchewan Party Candidate, Saskatoon Silver Springs.**


I have audited the return of election expenses of Ken Cheveldayoff for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the business manager as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I might have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of *The Election Act*, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10, 2007 to November 7, 2007.

A "**Schedule of Adjustments**" is attached which lists changes I determined to be necessary, further documentation required and items that were not included that should have been.

November 7, 2007 Election Candidate (Saskatoon Silver Springs)

1. Many proof of payments were unavailable since bank statements and related cancelled cheques after December 31, 2007.
2. The invoice for \$1,012.19 from Rawlco Radio was not available (the cancelled cheque was available).
3. The *Donor's Statement* from Tri-Sec Financial Group and Western Business Machines were unsigned. Tri-Sec Financial Group paid an invoice on behalf of the campaign in the amount of \$2,067.00 to CBS Outdoors. Western Business Machines provided a photocopier to the campaign valued at \$1,000.00.
4. The contributions are understated by the amount of the donation-in-kind from Western Business Machines.

2. This Return must be accompanied by the auditor's report to the business manager of the candidate on the information given in this Return.

3. The commercial value of goods and services donated (other than volunteer labour or goods valued at \$200.00 or less), and the difference between the amount paid and the commercial value of goods and services provided, are considered to be election expenses. If the total of "commercial value" is greater than the total of "amount paid" it is the larger of the two figures that is used in the calculation of election expenses incurred by the candidate. 4. A statement, signed and receipted, by the donor and by the business manager, supported by a verification from an independent commercial source of the amount expensed must be submitted when making claim of commercial value as an election expense.

5. All payments of more than \$25.00 must be accompanied by a supplier document that states the particulars of the election expense and by a receipt or cancelled cheque that provides proof of payment. The supplier documents and proofs of payment must be submitted with this Return.

Revenue received by a candidate from fund-raising activities, meetings and sales of material of a promotional nature are deemed contributions. The total net proceeds from each source indicated must be recorded and, in the aggregate, reported in this Return.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
