## Independent Auditors' Report

To The Business Manager for Darryl Hickie:

We have audited the Return of Election Expenses of Darryl Hickie for the campaign period from October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011. The financial information has been prepared by the business manager and candidate based on the financial reporting provisions of section 261 of The Election Act, 1996.

### *Management's Responsibility for the Financial Information*

The business manager and candidate are responsible for the preparation of this financial information in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 and for such internal control as they determine is necessary to enable the preparation of financial information that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

### *Auditors' Responsibility*

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial information based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial information is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about amounts and disclosures in the financial information. The procedures selected depend on the auditors' judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial information, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation of the financial information in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the business manager and candidate, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial information.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

### *Basis for Qualified Opinion*

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

### *Qualified Opinion*

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the Return of Election Expenses of Darryl Hickie for the campaign period from October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011 is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of section 261 of The Election Act, 1996.

### *Basis of Accounting*

Without further modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the basis of accounting. The financial information is prepared to assist the business manager and candidate to comply with the financial reporting provisions of The Election Act, 1996. As a result, the financial information may not be suitable for another purpose.



The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.




