Pursuant to subsection 238 (5) of The Election Act, 1996,

I have audited the Candidate's Return of Election Expenses of "Independent" candidate Hafeez Chaudhuri for the campaign from October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011. This return is the responsibility of the Business Manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

I conducted my audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. This audit includes evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the Business Manager as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

As per my verification, funds were provided by the candidate himself, therefore a Donor's Statement has been submitted duly signed by the Donor/the candidate himself, by the Business Manager as an evidence to the fact's. Moreover CIBC Visa Credit Card statement is attached as a proof to the fore stated statement.

In my opinion, adjustments, if any, which I might have determined to be necessary is the service expenses total \$5610.57 instead of \$5464.83 which is considered to be material. Except that, I have been able to satisfy as to the completeness of the records. The return presents fairly in all material respects, and the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 to be detailed in the return of the election expenses for the campaign period October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011.

and I further solemnly declare that I will not, except so far as I may be permitted by law, at any future time make or be party to the making or giving of any payment, reward, office, employment or valuable consideration for the purpose of defraying any such expenses as last mentioned, or provide or be party to the providing of any money, security or equivalent for the purpose of defraying any such expenses;
and I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing it to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath, and by virtue of the Canada Evidence Act .
