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INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

To Alexander White, Chief Official Agent of the Committee to Elect Herb Cox for the Saskatchewan Party.

We have audited the Registered Political Party's Candidate's Return of Election Expenses of Herb Cox for the campaign period from October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The chief official agent is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of this financial information and for such internal control as the chief official agent determines is necessary to enable the preparation of this financial information that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditors' Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial information based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial information is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial information. The procedures selected depend on the auditors' judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial information, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditors consider internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial information in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial information.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of organizations of this type, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the candidate's accounting records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves concerning the completeness of the records referred to in the preceding paragraph, the Registered Political Party's Candidate's Return of Election Expenses presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of The Committee to Elect Herb Cox for the Saskatchewan Party as required by section 251 of *The Election Act, 1996* to be reported in the Candidate's Return of Election Expenses for the period from October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
