To the Business Manager for Ken Cheveldayoff Saskatchewan Party Candidate Saskatoon Silver Springs Candidate:

I have audited the return of election expenses of the Committee to Elect Ken Cheveldayoff for the campaign period from October 10 to November 7, 2011. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraphs, I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by business manager, as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

Section 240(6) of The Election Act 1996 requires contributions from a corporation, trust fund or constituency association to be accompanied by a statement which sets out the name of and the amount contributed by, each person who contributed in excess of \$ 250 in a year and whose contribution was used to make up the contribution from the corporation, constituency association or trust fund. The statement must identify the person authorized to make the contribution and must be certified by the business manager, that the information on the statement was true and correct.

The return includes two cash contributions from the constituency association and various contributions for payments of the candidate's election expenses. There was only one signed statement included in the candidate's records which confirmed a cash contribution of \$ 30,000. There were no statements for the additional cash contribution of \$ 20,000 or the expense payment contributions of \$ 11,420.71.

The return includes corporate contributions of \$ 4,000. There were no statements signed by the person authorized to make the corporate contribution or declaration if the corporate contribution included any individual contributions in excess of \$ 250.00 per year.

The return included personal contributions of \$ 3,650 which were segregated into contributions over \$ 250 and contributions less than \$ 250. The information in the return is correct based on the information that was entered in the deposit book but there was no information on hand to verify the names and amounts.

The expenditure under Part II (c) Hire of premises in the amount of \$ 1,951.81 in the return was for the rent of the constituency office during the writ period. The amount does seem reasonable but it is dated December 1, 2011 and does not identify the period that the rent related to. The rental agreement was not available to verify the details of the rent period.

The return includes payments under a joint agreement with the candidate's political party for advertising expenses in the amount of \$ 13,688.83. The joint agreement is to specify the administrator of the joint agreement, the candidate's proportion of the expenses, and method adopted for payment of the expense. Schedule B to the agreement refers to the candidate's share of the advertising expenses which was not available therefore I could not verify the candidate's share of the joint advertising expenses.

There were 5 cheques for expenditures that did not clear the bank account by January 14, 2012 therefore I could not examine the cancelled cheque to ensure that the details of the payment agreed to the expenditure included on the return. The total of these expenditures amounted to \$ 3,982.65. All cheques agreed to the check register.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraphs, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period October 10 to November 7 2011.

3. The commercial value of goods and services donated (other than volunteer labour or goods valued at \$200.00 or less), and the difference between the amount paid and the commercial value of goods and services provided, are considered to be election expenses. 4. A statement, signed and receipted, by the donor and by the business manager, supported by a verification from an independent commercial source of the amount expensed must be submitted when making claim of commercial value as an election expense.

5. All payments of more than \$25.00 must be accompanied by a supplier document that states the particulars of the election expense and by a receipt or cancelled cheque that provides proof of payment. The supplier documents and proofs of payment must be submitted with this Return.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
