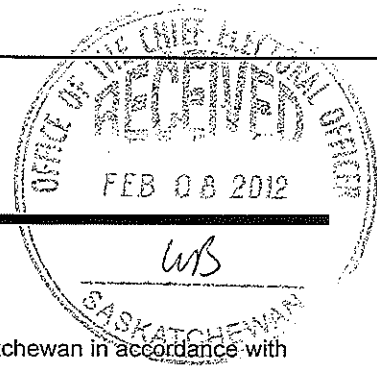

Independent Auditors' Report

To Carol Sliva, Business Manager for Ken Krawetz for submission to Elections Saskatchewan in accordance with *The Elections Act, 1996*

Report on the Return

We have audited the accompanying Candidate's Return of Election Expenses (the "Return") for the candidacy of Ken Krawetz, a candidate at the election of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan held on the 7th day of November, 2011 in the constituency of Canora-Pelly, which comprises the Summary of Contributions and Expenses and Related Schedules for the campaign period from September 1, 2011 to January 25, 2012.

This Return has been prepared by the business manager for the candidate based on the financial reporting provisions require by section 261 of *The Elections Act, 1996*.

The Business Manager's Responsibility for the Return

The business manager of the campaign is responsible for the preparation of the Return in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of section 261 of the *The Elections Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan and for such internal control as the business manager determines is necessary to enable the preparation of a Return that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Return based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements, and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the Return is free of material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the Return. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Return, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the preparation of the Return in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the business manager, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the Return.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions in any electoral campaign, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the campaign's accounting records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions and other revenue and expenses.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the "Basis for Qualified Opinion" paragraph, the Candidate's Return of Election Expenses of Ken Krawetz, for the campaign period from September 1, 2011 to January 25, 2012, is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the reporting provisions of section 261 of the *The Elections Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use

The Return is prepared to assist the official agent to meet the requirements of the *The Elections Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan. As a result, the Return may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the business manager, candidate or the Chief Electoral Officer, and should not be used by parties other than the business manager, the candidate or the Chief Electoral Officer.
