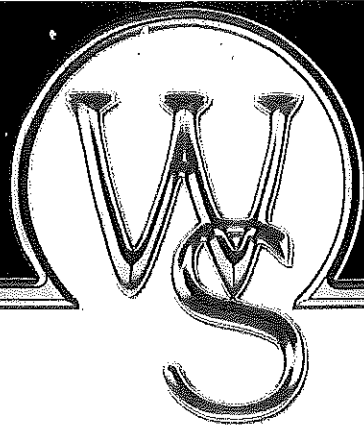

To the Business Manager for Roger Parent Saskatchewan Party Candidate Saskatoon Meewasin Candidate:

I have audited the return of election expenses of the Committee to Elect Roger Parent for the campaign period from October 10 to November 7, 2011. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraphs, I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by business manager, as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

Section 240(6) of The Election Act 1996 requires contributions from a corporation, trust fund or constituency association to be accompanied by a statement which sets out the name of and the amount contributed by, each person who contributed in excess of \$ 250 in a year and whose contribution was used to make up the contribution from the corporation, constituency association or trust fund. The statement must identify the person authorized to make the contribution and must be certified by the business manager, that the information on the statement was true and correct.


The return includes various contributions from constituency offices. The contributions from the Saskatoon Meewasin Constituency do not agree with the statement of contributions from the constituency association. There were no statements of contribution from the Saskatoon Silver Springs and Saskatoon Southeast constituency associations.

The return includes corporate contributions of \$ 23,630. There were no statements signed by the person authorized to make the corporate contribution or declaration if the corporate contribution included any individual contributions in excess of \$ 250.00 per year.

The return includes contributions under the category of Other Persons or Group of Persons in the amount of \$ 1,500. The amount was also included as expenditure under the expenditure for goods (page 2). This amount represents signs and rebar that was a carry over from the 2007 Saskatchewan election. There was no supporting documentation as to the quantities or original cost. The costs may also have been claimed on a previous candidates election campaign expenditure return.

The return includes donations in kind that amounted to \$ 2,700. The donations in kind were recorded under individual contributions in the amount of \$ 1,700 and corporate donations in excess of \$ 250 in the amount of \$ 1,000. The expenditures were recorded as services in the amount of \$ 1,200 and goods in the amount if \$ 1,500. There was no supporting documentation as to the market value and the donor's statements were not signed.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraphs, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period October 10 to November 7 2011.

2. This Return must be accompanied by the auditor's report to the business manager of the candidate on the information given in this Return.

3. The commercial value of goods and services donated (other than volunteer labour or goods valued at \$200.00 or less), and the difference between the amount paid and the commercial value of goods and services provided, are considered to be election expenses. If the total of "commercial value" is greater than the total of "amount paid" it is the larger of the two figures that is used in the calculation of election expenses incurred by the candidate. 4. A statement, signed and receipted, by the donor and by the business manager, supported by a verification from an independent commercial source of the amount expended must be submitted when making claim of commercial value as an election expense.

5. All payments of more than \$25.00 must be accompanied by a supplier document that states the particulars of the election expense and by a receipt or cancelled cheque that provides proof of payment. The supplier documents and proofs of payment must be submitted with this Return.

Revenue received by a candidate from fund-raising activities, meetings and sales of material of a promotional nature are deemed contributions. The total net proceeds from each source indicated must be recorded and, in the aggregate, reported in this Return.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
