**INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT**

To the Business Manager of Zoria Broughton

We have audited the return of election expenses of Zoria Broughton for the campaign period from October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011. This return has been prepared by the business manager of Zoria Broughton based on the financial reporting provisions of section 261 of *The Election Act, 1996*.

**Business Manager's Responsibility for the Election Return**

The business manager is responsible for the preparation of the return of election expenses of Zoria Broughton for the campaign period from October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011 and for such internal control as the business manager determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the return that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

**Auditors' Responsibility**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the return is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the return. The procedures selected depend on the auditors' judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the return, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the preparation of the return in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the business manager as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the return.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

### **Basis for Qualified Opinion**

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

### **Qualified Opinion**

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by section 261 of *The Election Act, 1996* to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from October 10, 2011 to November 7, 2011.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
