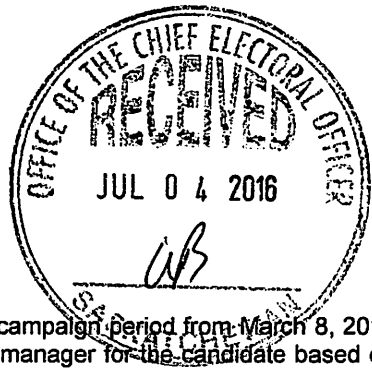

Independent Auditors' Report

To The Business Manager for Thomas Sierzycki:

We have audited the Return of Election Expenses of Thomas Sierzycki for the campaign period from March 8, 2016 to April 4, 2016. The financial information has been prepared by the business manager for the candidate based on the financial reporting provisions of section 261 of The Election Act, 1996.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Information

The business manager for the candidate is responsible for the preparation of this financial information in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 and for such internal control as the business manager determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial information that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditors' Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial information based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial information is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about amounts and disclosures in the financial information. The procedures selected depend on the auditors' judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial information, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation of the financial information in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the business manager for the candidate, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial information.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of electoral campaigns, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager for the candidate and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary with respect to any unrecorded transactions.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves as to the completeness of the transactions as described in the preceding paragraph, the Return of Election Expenses of Thomas Sierzycki for the campaign period from March 8, 2016 to April 4, 2016 is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of section 261 of The Election Act, 1996.

Basis of Accounting

Without further modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the basis of accounting. The financial information is prepared to assist the business manager and candidate to comply with the financial reporting provisions of The Election Act, 1996. As a result, the financial information may not be suitable for another purpose.

Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

As required by the financial reporting provisions of The Election Act, 1996, we report that the candidate and the business manager provided all requested information and explanations, and that in our opinion the business manager kept proper accounting records.


