

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: Jim Turner
Business Manager
The Saskatchewan Party Jim Reiter Campaign

Report on the Return

I have audited the accompanying Candidate's Return of Election Expenses (the "return") for the candidacy of Jim Reiter, a candidate in the election of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan held on the 4th day of April, 2016. The Return is comprised of Summary of Contributions and Expenses, Part I – Details of Contributions, Part II – Details of Expenses, Declaration of a Business Manager of a Candidate and Candidate's Declaration as to Expenses. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Business Manager's Responsibility for the Return of Election Expenses

The Business Manager is responsible for the preparation of the election return in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of The Elections Act, 1996 and for such internal control as the financial agent determines is necessary to enable the preparation of election financing reports that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on the election return based on my audit. I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards as required by Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 (Saskatchewan). Those standards require that I comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the election expense return is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the election expense return. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of risks of material misstatement of the election expense return; wither due to error or fraud. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Business Manager's preparation of the election expense return in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the Business Manager, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the election expense return.

I believe that the audit evidence obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my qualified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions of the candidate's campaign required by Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period from March 8, 2016 to April 4, 2016.

4. A statement, signed and receipted, by the donor and by the business manager, supported by a verification from an independent commercial source of the amount expended must be submitted when making claim of commercial value as an election expense.

5. All payments of more than \$25.00 must be accompanied by a supplier document that states the particulars of the election expense and by a receipt or cancelled cheque that provides proof of payment. The supplier documents and proofs of payment must be submitted with this Return.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.




