To the Business Manager for Judy Mergel Green Party Candidate Wood River Candidate:

I have audited the return of election expenses of the Committee to Elect Judy Mergel for the campaign period from March 8 to April 4, 2016. This return is the responsibility of the business manager. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the return based on my audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraphs, I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the return is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examination, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the return. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by business manager, as well as evaluating the overall return presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all transactions for the campaign period. Accordingly my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the business manager and candidate and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to those expenses.

Section 240(6) of The Election Act 1996 requires contributions from a corporation, trust fund or constituency association to be accompanied by a statement which sets out the name of and the amount contributed by, each person who contributed in excess of \$250 in a year and whose contribution was used to make up the contribution from the corporation, constituency association or trust fund. The statement must identify the person authorized to make the contribution and must be certified by the business manager, that the information on the statement was true and correct.

There are three contributions from the individual, Judy Mergel, totaling \$1,473.48. The candidate made two donations in kind for travel and for advertising in the newspaper. There is a Donor's Statement to verify the amount. The remaining \$1,000.00 is a contribution by the candidate and it matches a deposit made to the bank account dated March 10th, 2016.

On Part II (a) Candidate's Campaign Expenses, there is an expenditure of \$430.08 for a private vehicle. The total mileage stated on the Travel Claim statement was 1024 km at a rate of \$0.42 per kilometer was expensed. The candidate made a


donation of kind for the usage of travel expenses and were not expensed through the candidate's bank account.

The expense of \$113.40 on Part II (d) Advertising is for an advertisement placed in the Assiniboia Times Newspaper. The commercial value is \$113.40 but due to the donation in kind by the candidate, the amount paid resulted in a total of \$70.00. The expense paid agrees to the invoices but they are not paid through the bank account.

The expense on Part II (e) Services, is for postage through Canada Post and bank charges and checks. The total cost for the service is \$533.15. The expense from Canada Post is verified through invoices from the vendor, however they are not paid through the bank account. Also, the candidate received \$81.75 towards these disbursements, the balance did not go through the bank.

On Part II (f) Goods Supplied, the return includes a \$649.00 expense. The amount is used for printing flyers and signs. There are invoices from Able11Print and Rayacom Regina for the supplies to verify the amounts. The supplies are bought through the candidate's account and the bank statement agrees to the amounts given.

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which I have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraphs, the return presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial transactions the candidate's campaign required by Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 to be detailed in the return of election expenses for the campaign period March 8 to April 4, 2016.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the business manager where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
