

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To, Blaise Ross, business manager for Constance Maffenbeier for submission to the Chief electoral Officer of Saskatchewan in accordance with Section 261 of the Election Act, 1996

QUALIFIED OPINION

We have audited the accompanying Candidate's Elections Expense Return (the "Return') for the candidacy of Constance Maffenbeier (the "Candidate"), a Candidate at the election of a member to serve intended legislative Assembly of contributions and Expenses. Schedules of Contributions from Individuals, Corporations, Trade Unions, Unincorporated Organizations or Associations and Any Other persons or Groups of Persons and Statements of Expenses for Candidate's Personal Expenses, Candidate's Campaign Expenses, Hire of Premises, Advertising, Services, Goods Supplies, Travel and Hire of Vehicle, Undisputed claims Unpaid and Disputed Claims Unpaid for the electoral campaign ending November 18, 2020:

October 26,2020

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of electoral campaigns, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verifications. Accordingly, our verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the campaign's accounting records and we are not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions and other revenue and expenses.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditors Responsibilities for the Audit of the Return section of our report. We are independent of the Candidate in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Return in Saskatchewan, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the Note X to the Return which describes the basis of accounting. The Return is prepared to assist the business manager to meet the requirements of The Elections Act 1996 and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan. As a result, the Return may not be suitable for another purpose. Out report is intended solely for the business manager, the candidate and the Chief Electoral Officer, and should not be used by parties other than the business manager, the candidate or the Chief Electoral Officer.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the candidate's financial report process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Return

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Return as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue and auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, the could reasonable be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Return. As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards we exercise professional judgement and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

• Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Return, whether due to fraud or error, design and

perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentation or override of internal control.

- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the campaign's internal control
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosure made by the business manager.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit

REPORT ON OTHER LEGAL AND REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

As required by subsection 238(6) of The Election Act, 1996, in our opinion, the Return presents the information containing the financial records on which it is based.

REPORT ON THE CHECKLIST FOR AUDITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ELECTION ACT 1996 REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with Section 222 of *The Election Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan, we have been engaged to complete the attached E440 - Candidate Election Expe3nse Return Audit Checklist. This other reporting responsibility relates to our audit of the Return. We prepared the E-440 - Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist. This report has bee prepared in accordance with Canadian standard on Related Services (CSRS) 4460, Reports on Supplementary Matters Arising from an Audit or a Review Engagement. Our responsibility is to report on the E-440 - Candidate election Expense Return Audit Checklist. This standard requires us to comply with ethical requirements and to plan and perform procedures to address the other reporting responsibility. The procedures were selected based on our professional judgement to enable us to form a basis for this report. The procedures vary in nature from, and are less in extent than for those required then providing an audit opinion or a review conclusion. Users are cautioned that the procedures performed may not be suitable for their purposes.

Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion or a review conclusion on the E-440 - Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist.

b) Candidates Not Endorsed by a Registered Political Party

If the value of all contributions received exceeds the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of the candidate, the Minister of Finance shall pay no reimbursement.

If the value of all contributions received does not exceed the election expenses but the value of those contributions and the reimbursement calculated exceeds the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of the candidate, the Minister of Finance shall pay to the business manager an amount equal to the election expenses less the contributions received.

Death or Withdrawal of Candidate (Section 271)

If the candidate dies or withdraws from an election and prior to the death or withdrawal, the value of all contributions to the candidate exceeds the candidate's election expenses, the candidate's business manager shall:

- a) where the candidate was endorsed by a registered political party, pay the excess amount to the chief official agent of the registered political party.
- b) where the candidate was not endorsed by a registered political party, pay the excess amount to the Minister of Finance.

Further, if the candidate dies or withdraws before appointing a business manager, the candidate's estate or the candidate shall pay the excess amount in accordance with the above.
