To Reina Sinclair, Business Manager for Robert Rudachyk for submission to the Chief Electoral Officer of Saskatchewan in accordance with Section 261 of *The Elections Act* 1996.,

Report of the Return

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Candidate's Return of Election Expenses (the "Return") for the candidacy of Robert Rudachyk, a candidate at the election of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan held on the 26 day of October, 2020 in the constituency of Saskatoon Westview which comprises the Summary of Contributions and Expenses, Schedules of Contributions from Individual, Corporations, Trade Unions, Unincorporated Organization or Associations and Any Other Persons or Groups of Persons and Statements of Expenses Candidate's Personal Expenses, Petty Expenses, Hire of Premises, Advertising, Services, Goods Supplied, Travel and Hire of Vehicle, Undisputed Claims Unpaid, and Disputed Claims Unpaid for the electoral campaign ending October 26, 2020.

This return has been prepared by the business manager for the Candidate based on the financial reporting provisions of Section 261 of *The Elections Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan.

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the Return of Robert Rudachyk, is prepared, in all material respects in accordance with the reporting provisions of Section 261 of *The Elections Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of electoral campaigns, the completeness of contributions and other revenues and expenses is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the campaign's accounting records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions and other revenues and expenses.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Audit of the Return section of our report. We are independent of the Candidate in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Return in Saskatchewan., and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the Note 1 to The Return, which describes the basis of accounting. The Return is prepared to assist the business manager to meet the requirements of *The Elections Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan. As a result, the Return may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the business manager, the candidate or the Chief Officer, and should not be used by other parties.

The Business Manager's Responsibilities for the Return

The business manager of the candidate is responsible for the preparation of the Return in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Section 261 of *The Elections Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan and for such internal control as the business manager determines is necessary to enable the preparation of a Return that is free from material misstatements, whether due to fraud or error.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Candidate's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Return

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Return as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Return. As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgement and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Returns, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal controls.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the campaign's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the business manager. We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

As required by Section 238(6) of *The Election Act, 1996*, in our opinion, the Return presents the information contained in the financial records on which it is based.

Report on the Checklist for Audits in Accordance with *the Election Act, 1996* Requirements

In accordance with Section 222 of *the Elections Act, 1996* and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan, we have been engaged to complete the attached E-440 – Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist. This other reporting responsibility relates to our audit of the Return. We prepared the E-440- Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist.

This report has been prepared in accordance with Canadian Standard on Related Services (CSRS) 4460 Reports on Supplementary Matters Arising from an Audit or a Review Engagement. Our responsibility is to report on the E-440 – Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist. This standard requires us to comply with ethical requirements and to plan and perform procedures to address the other reporting responsibility. The procedures were selected based on our professional judgement to enable us to form a basis for this report. The procedures vary in nature from, and are less in extent than for, those required when providing an audit opinion or a review conclusion. Users are cautioned that the procedures may not be suitable for their purposes.

Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion or a review conclusion on the E-440- Candidate Election Expenses Return Audit Checklist.

In response to the other reporting responsibility, we completed the E-440-Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist using knowledge obtained during our audit of the Return.

Designation of Reimbursement (Section 269 and 270)

a) Candidates Endorsed by a Registered Political Party

If eligible for reimbursement, the Candidate directs the Minister of Finance to pay any reimbursement to (check one):

- Chief Official Agent of the Registered Political Party
 Constituency Association

If the value of all contributions and any reimbursement received exceeds the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of the candidate, the candidate's business manager shall pay the excess amount to the chief official agent of the registered political party or the candidate's constituency association, as directed by the candidate.

b) Candidates Not Endorsed by a Registered Political Party

If the value of all contributions received exceeds the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of the candidate, the Minister of Finance shall pay no reimbursement.

If the value of all contributions received does not exceed the election expenses but the value of those contributions and the reimbursement calculated exceeds the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of the candidate, the Minister of Finance shall pay to the business manager an amount equal to the election expenses less the contributions received.

Death or Withdrawal of Candidate (Section 271)

If the candidate dies or withdraws from an election and prior to the death or withdrawal, the value of all contributions to the candidate exceeds the candidate's election expenses, the candidate's business manager shall:

- a) where the candidate was endorsed by a registered political party, pay the excess amount to the chief official agent of the registered political party.
b) where the candidate was not endorsed by a registered political party, pay the excess amount to the Minister of Finance.

Further, if the candidate dies or withdraws before appointing a business manager, the candidate's estate or the candidate shall pay the excess amount in accordance with the above.
