

Application for Extension to File Candidate's Election Expense Return

E-412X The Election Act, 1996 Section 261, 263 Revised 2018

Pursuant to Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996, a financial agent must file the Candidate's Election Expense Return (Form E-412) for the 2024 General Election held on October 28, 2024 on or before January 28, 2025.

Application for Extension:

Talon Regent, financial agent for Melissa Patterson who was a candidate in the constituency of MOOSE JAW WAKAMOW, has applied pursuant to clause 263(1)(b) for an extension of 7 days to prepare and file the return for the following reason:

Audit delay.

Exception provided by order:

In my opinion, an extension of 7 days is reasonable and the following authorization necessary.

This order of the Chief Electoral Officer applies as follows:

Extension of time to prepare and file the required Candidate's Election Expenses Return (Form E-412) for Melissa Patterson, a candidate in the 2024 General Election held on October 28, 2024, in the constituency of MOOSE JAW WAKAMOW.

Pursuant to clause 263(3)(a), the Chief Electoral Officer grants an extension of 7 days to financial agent Talon Regent. Specifically, the aforementioned campaign has until the close of business on February 4, 2025 to meet the requirements of Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996.
