## INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON CANDIDATE'S ELECTION EXPENSES RETURN

#### REPORT ON THE RETURN

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Candidate's Elections Expense Return (the "Return") for the candidacy of **Dale Hrynuik** (the "Candidate"), a candidate at the election of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan held on the **28 day of October**, **2024** in the constituency of Saskatoon Centre, which comprises the Summary of Contributions and Expenses, Schedules of Contributions from Individuals, Corporations, Trade Unions, Unincorporated Organizations or Associations and Any Other Persons or Groups of Persons and Statements of Expenses for Candidate's Personal Expenses, Candidate's Campaign Expenses, Hire of Premises, Advertising, Services, Goods Supplied, Travel and Hire of Vehicle, Undisputed Claims Unpaid and Disputed Claims Unpaid for the electoral campaign ending **October 28, 2024**.

This Return has been prepared by the financial agent for the candidate based on the financial reporting provisions Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan.

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the Return of **Dale Hrynuik** is prepared, in all material respects in accordance with the reporting provisions of Section 261 of the The Election Act, 1996 and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of electoral campaigns, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the campaign's accounting records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions and other revenue and expenses.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Return section of our report. We are independent of the Candidate in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Return in Saskatchewan, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to Note 1 to the Return, which describes the basis of accounting. The Return is prepared to assist the financial agent to meet the requirements of The Elections Act, 1996 and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan. As a result, the Return may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the financial agent, the candidate and the Chief Electoral Officer, and should not be used by parties other than the financial agent, the candidate or the Chief Electoral Officer.

Financial Agent's Responsibilities for the Return

The financial agent of the candidate is responsible for the preparation of the Return in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan and for such internal control as the financial agent determines is necessary to enable the preparation of a Return that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Candidate's financial reporting process.

#### Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Return

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Return as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Return. As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Return, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the campaign's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the financial agent.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

As required by subsection 238(6) of The Election Act, 1996, in our opinion, the Return presents the information contained in the financial records on which it is based.

Report on the Checklist for Audits in Accordance with The Election Act, 1996 Requirements

In accordance with Section 222 of The Election Act, 1996 and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan, we have been engaged to complete the attached E-440 – Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist. This other reporting responsibility relates to our audit of the Return. We prepared the E-440 – Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist.

This report has been prepared in accordance with Canadian Standard on Related Services (CSRS) 4460, Reports on Supplementary Matters Arising from an Audit or a Review Engagement. Our responsibility is to report on the E-440 - Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist. This standard requires us to comply with ethical requirements and to plan and perform procedures to address the other reporting responsibility. The procedures were selected based on our professional judgment to enable us to form a basis for this report. The procedures vary in nature from, and are less in extent than for, those required when providing an audit opinion or a review conclusion. Users are cautioned that the procedures performed may not be suitable for their purposes.

Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion or a review conclusion on the E-440 – Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist.

In response to the other reporting responsibility, we completed the E-440 – Candidate Election Expense Return Audit Checklist using knowledge obtained during our audit of the Return.

#### 1. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the audit of the Candidate's Election Expenses Return is based on the financial reporting provisions Section 261 of The Election Act, 1996 and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Saskatchewan. This is a modified historical cost basis, reflecting cash transactions within the election period with the addition of the following:

- Accounting for Donations in-kind.
- Claims still unpaid.
- Removal of reimbursed Candidate expenses outside the election period

#### Designation of Reimbursement (Section 269 and 270)

#### a) Candidates Endorsed by a Registered Political Party

If eligible for reimbursement, the Candidate directs the Minister of Finance to pay any reimbursement to (check one):

Chief Official Agent of the Registered Political Party

Constituency Association

If the value of all contributions and any reimbursement received exceeds the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of the candidate, the candidate's financial agent shall pay the excess amount to the chief official agent of the registered political party or the candidate's constituency association, as directed by the candidate.

#### b) Candidates Not Endorsed by a Registered Political Party

If the value of all contributions received exceeds the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of the candidate, the Minister of Finance shall pay no reimbursement.

If the value of all contributions received does not exceed the election expenses but the value of those contributions and the reimbursement calculated exceeds the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of the candidate, the Minister of Finance shall pay to the financial agent an amount equal to the election expenses less the contributions received.

#### **Death or Withdrawal of Candidate (Section 271)**

If the candidate dies or withdraws from an election and prior to the death or withdrawal, the value of all contributions to the candidate exceeds the candidate's election expenses, the candidate's financial agent shall:

- a) where the candidate was endorsed by a registered political party, pay the excess amount to the chief official agent of the registered political party.
- b) where the candidate was not endorsed by a registered political party, pay the excess amount to the Minister of Finance.

Further, if the candidate dies or withdraws before appointing a financial agent, the candidate's estate or the candidate shall pay the excess amount in accordance with the above.

The value of donations in kind must be recorded and included as a contribution received by the financial agent where claimed as an election expense. Accordingly, commercial value is an election expense and a contribution concurrently.
