


Proclamation of the Returning Officer Declaring the Time and Place for the Nomination of Candidates and the Day of Opening the Polling Places

Proclamation

Constituency of MEADOW LAKE

His Majesty's Writ bearing the date October 1st, 2024, having been directed to me, public notice is now given:

- 1. That I am commanded to cause an election, to be held according to law, of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan for the above-mentioned constituency.
- 2. That I will, on October 12th, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. attend at Highway #4 North, Meadow Lake, to receive nominations.
- 3. That in case voting of voters is required, polling places will be open October 22nd to October 26th, 2024 from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and on October 28, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
