



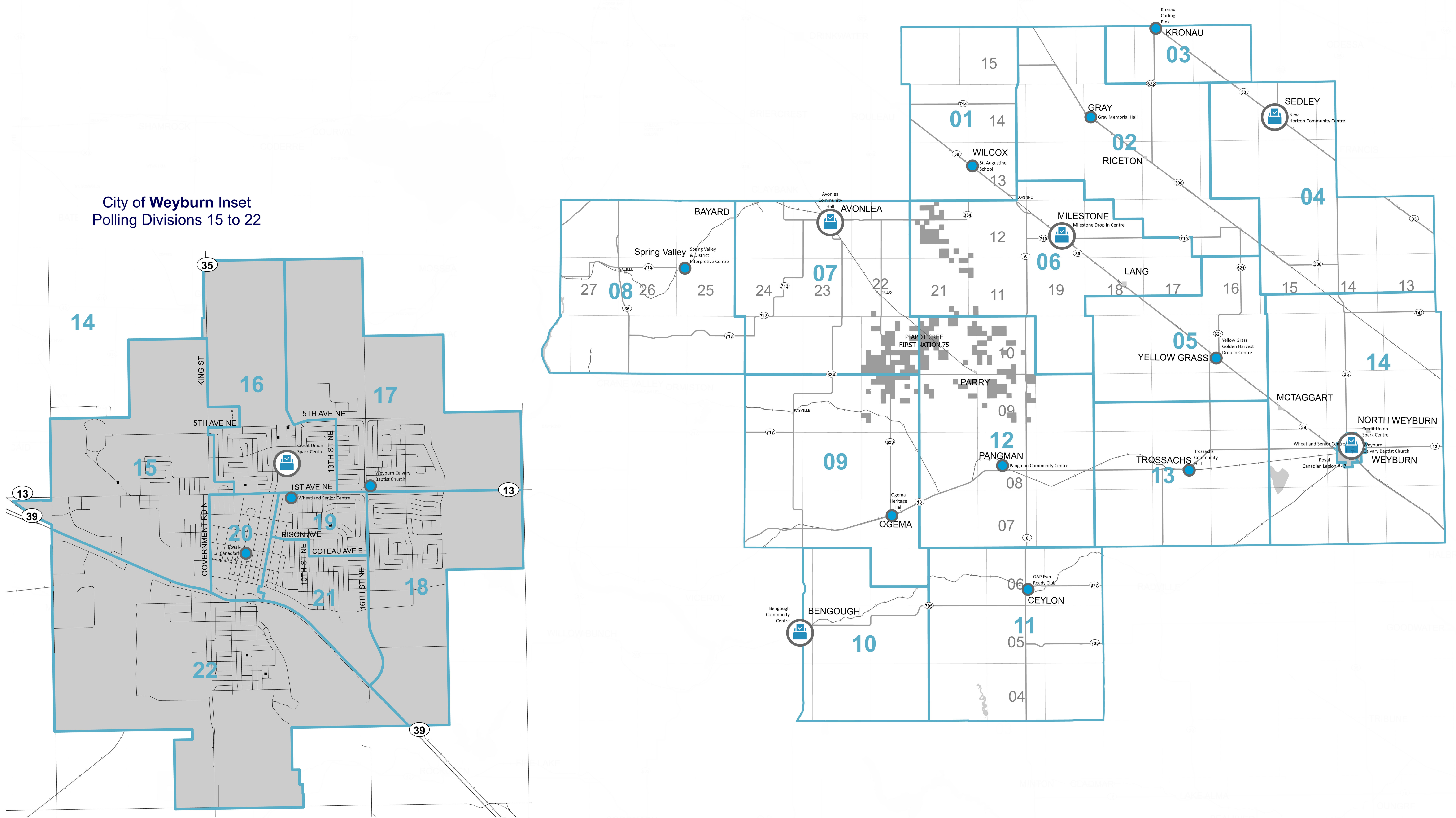
Proclamation of the Returning Officer Declaring the Time and Place for the Nomination of Candidates and the Day of Opening the Polling Places

# Proclamation

## Constituency of WEYBURN-BENGOUGH

His Majesty's Writ bearing the date October 1st, 2024, having been directed to me, public notice is now given:

1. That I am commanded to cause an election, to be held according to law, of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan for the above-mentioned constituency.
2. That I will, on October 12th, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. attend at 28 12th Street, Weyburn, to receive nominations.
3. That in case voting of voters is required, polling places will be open October 22nd to October 26th, 2024 from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and on October 28, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.



4a. All eligible voters may vote at any of the following voting locations between **October 22nd to October 26th, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., unless otherwise stated:**

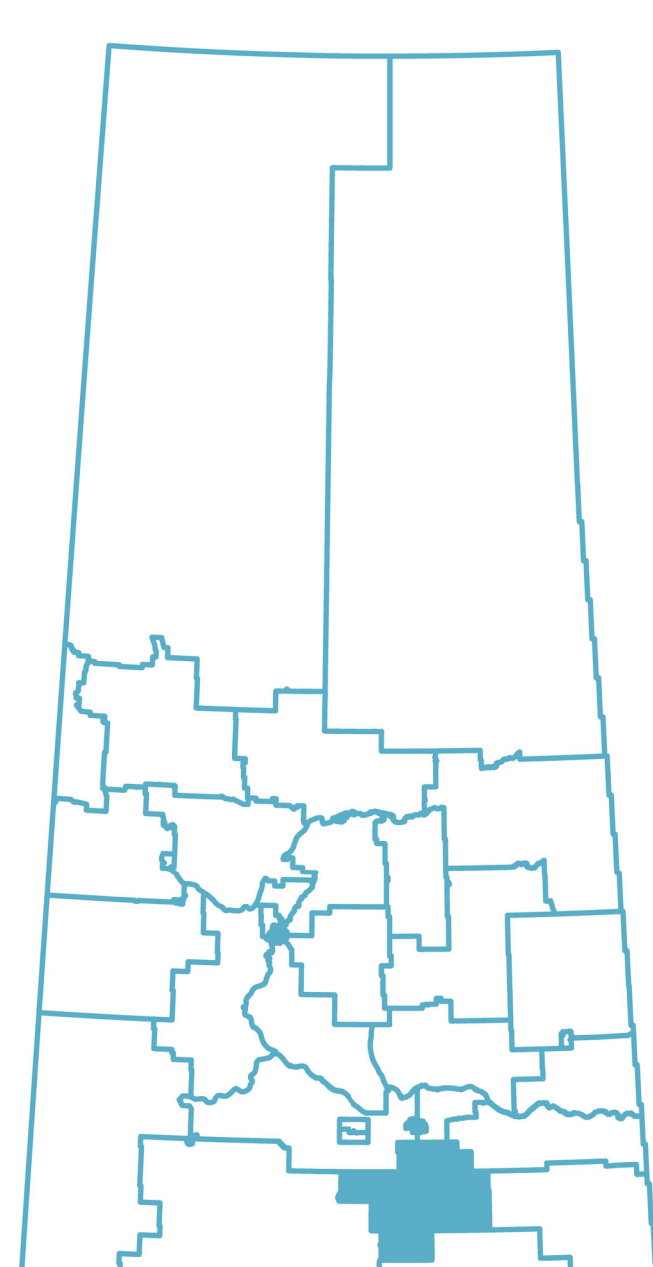
6. That Hospital and Remand Centre voting locations will be established at the following locations during the following times:

- Weyburn General Hospital, 201 1st Avenue Northeast, Weyburn (October 28th: 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.)

7. That at 200 Lakeshore Drive, Regina, on the 9th day of November, 2024, at the hour of 9:00 a.m., the ballot boxes and, in the case of a general election, the ballot envelopes containing the ballots of voters at hospitals and remand centres shall be opened and counted and, where there are voters who voted by mail and displaced voters, open the ballot envelopes containing the ballots of those voters and count those ballots and make the addition of the votes given for each candidate and declare elected the candidate having the largest number of votes.

All persons are required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.  
All times in this proclamation are Central Standard Time.

### Warning

189(1) No person shall unlawfully take down, cover up, mutilate, deface or alter an election proclamation, notice or other document required to be posted pursuant to this Act. Any person violating the provision of subsection 189(1) is guilty of an offence and, subject to subsection 216(2) of this Act, if convicted, is liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to both.
