OFFICIAL REPORT

The Seventeenth Saskatchewan Legislature was dissolved on 13 May 1975 by the Honourable Stephen Worobetz, Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 3 of *The Legislative Assembly Act*. On the same day an Order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council was passed pursuant to Section 4 of *The Election Act, 1971* directing the Chief Electoral Officer to issue a Writ of Election to each of sixty-one returning officers whose names are set out in Appendix I of this report.

The nomination of candidates took place on Monday, 26 May 1975. One hundred eighty-eight candidates were nominated; sixty-one Liberal, sixty-one New Democratic Party, thirty-one Progressive Conservative, and five Independent. Appendix II contains a list of the names, addresses and occupations of the candidates nominated together with the names and addresses of their respective business managers. No candidate withdrew from the election and no candidate was elected by acclamation.

An enumeration of eligible electors was conducted in each of 2,611 polling divisions between 13 May and 23 May 1975.

Advance polling stations were established in one or more places in each constituency and voting was conducted at each of the advance polling stations on 4, 5, 6, 7, and 9 June. One hundred fifty advance polling stations were established throughout the province.

Special polling stations were established in two hundred three hospitals and sanatoria for the benefit of patients receiving care in such institutions.

Regular polling stations were open between nine o'clock a.m. and eight o'clock p.m. C. S. T. on 11 June 1975. Unofficial results on the evening of 11 June 1975 showed thirty-eight New Democratic Party, fifteen Liberal, and seven Progressive Conservative candidates elected. Results in one constituency (Arm River) showed the Liberal and New Democratic Party candidates with an equal number of votes.

On 23 June 1975 returning officers made an addition of votes cast by voters at the advance and regular polling stations and a majority of returning officers counted ballots cast by patients at hospitals and sanatoria and by physically incapacitated voters who voted pursuant to Section 87A of *The Election Act, 1971*. No candidate or representative of a candidate was present at the final addition in the constituencies of Humboldt, Regina Lakeview, and Saskatoon Eastview and in accordance with Sections 87A(11) and 95(2) of the Act, returning officers in those constituencies did not count ballots cast by patients at hospitals and sanatoria, and by physically incapacitated voters. Official results of the addition of votes are set out in respect of each constituency in Appendix III of this Report.

On 4 July 1975 each of fifty-eight returning officers made a return to the Writ of Election that was issued to them.

A judicial recount of ballots was applied for and conducted in respect of each of the following three constituencies: Arm River (11 - 13 August), Meadow Lake (5 - 6 August), Morse (7 - 8 July).

The Chief Electoral Officer published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette* (Vol. 71, Nos. 29, 31, 35) notices of the receipt of the returns and the names of the candidates elected to the Legislature. The names of the candidates elected are shown in Appendix IV of this Report.

Deposits were forfeited by thirty-seven candidates; eleven Liberal, one New Democratic Party, twenty-one Progressive Conservative, and four Independent.

The 1975 general election was the first Saskatchewan provincial election conducted on constituency boundaries that were drawn by a Constituency Boundaries Commission. The Commission presented its final report to the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly in November, 1973. Boundaries drawn by the Commission were adopted by resolution of the Legislative Assembly and enacted in *The Representation Act, 1974* (S. S. 1973-74; c. 91; 1974-75; c. 39). Appendix IX of this Report contains an illustration of the constituency boundaries drawn pursuant to the above-mentioned Act.

Information is not contained in this Report with respect to financial contributions received and expenditures made by candidates and recognized political parties in conjunction with the eighteenth general election. Such information is set out in a Report of the Chief Electoral Officer Respecting Election Campaign Receipts and Expenditures, copies of which will be available from the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer during the first quarter of 1976.

In the appendices of this Report the names of recognized political parties that fielded candidates at the election have been abbreviated as follows: Saskatchewan Liberal Association — L.; The Saskatchewan Section of the New Democratic Party — N. D. P.; Progressive Conservative Party of Saskatchewan — P. C.
