Report of the Chief Electoral Officer

(Part I)

Official Report

The Twenty-First Saskatchewan Legislature was dissolved on Friday, 20 September 1991 by the Honourable Sylvia O. Fedoruk, Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 3 of *The Legislative Assembly and Executive Council Act*. On the same day an Order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council was passed pursuant to Section 4 of *The Election Act* directing the Chief Electoral Officer to issue a Writ of Election to each of 66 returning officers whose names and respective constituencies, are set out in Part I, Appendix I of this Report.

The boundaries of the provincial constituencies were as established in 1988 under *The Electoral Boundaries Commission Act*. The mandatory requirement under the Act of 2 northern constituencies, 29 urban and 35 rural constituencies increases the number of provincial constituencies to 66; as compared to 64 in 1986. Boundaries drawn by the Commission were adopted by resolution of the Legislative Assembly and enacted in *The Representation Act, 1989* (S.S. 1989-90 c.R-20.2 s.4). Part II, Appendix VII of this Report contains an illustration of the constituency boundaries pursuant to the above-mentioned Act.

At the time of the general election there were 4 political parties registered in the Register of Political Parties kept by the Chief Electoral Officer pursuant to Section 203.1 of *The Election Act*:

Saskatchewan Liberal Association
New Democratic Party, Sask. Section
The Progressive Conservative Party of Saskatchewan
Independence Party of Saskatchewan (W.C.C.)

The nomination of candidates took place on Saturday, 5 October 1991. By close of nomination at 2:00 p.m., 207 candidates had been nominated; 66 Liberal, 66 New Democrats, 66 Progressive Conservatives, 1 Independence (W.C.C.), and 8 Independent. Part II, Appendix III of this Report contains a list of the names, addresses and occupations of the candidates nominated together with the names and addresses of their respective business managers. No candidate withdrew from the election and no candidate was elected by acclamation.

An enumeration of eligible electors was conducted in each of the 2,657 polling divisions in the province between 23 September 1991 and 30 September 1991, and on Court of Revision, 17 October 1991. There were 652,233 names appearing on the revised list of voters.

Advance polling stations were established in one or more places in each constituency and voting was conducted at each of the advance polls on 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 September. There were 144 advance polling stations throughout the province.

Special polling stations were established in 134 hospitals and sanatoria for the benefit of patients receiving care in such institutions and in 4 correctional centres for the benefit of prisoners held in remand.

Physically incapacitated voters who were unable to go in person to either a regular or advance polling station were entitled to vote by mail-in ballot.

Regular polling stations were open between 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. C.S.T. on 21 October 1991. Unofficial results on the evening of 21 October 1991 showed 55 New Democrats, 10 Progressive Conservatives and 1 Liberal elected.

On 2 November 1991 returning officers made an addition of votes cast by voters at the regular and advance polling stations and the majority of returning officers counted ballots cast by patients at hospitals, prisoners in remand and physically incapacitated voters who voted by mail-in ballot. No candidate or representative of a candidate was present at the final addition in the constituencies of Athabasca, Maple Creek, Regina Churchill Downs, Regina Rosemont, Rosnher and Saskatoon Fairview and in accordance with Section 97(2) of the Act, returning officers in those constituencies did not count ballots cast by patients at hospitals and by prisoners held in remand. Official results of the addition of votes are set out in respect of each constituency in Part I, Appendix III of this Report.

On 13 November 1991 each of 66 returning officers made a return to the Writ of Election that was issued to them.

The Chief Electoral Officer published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette* (Vol.87, No.49) notices of the receipt of the returns and the names of the candidates elected to the Legislature. The names of the candidates elected are shown in Part I, Appendix II of this Report.

Deposits were forfeited by 80 candidates; 42 Liberal, 29 Progressive Conservatives, 1 Independence (W.C.C.) and 8 Independent.

In the Appendices of this Report the names of registered political parties that fielded candidates at the election have been abbreviated as follows: Saskatchewan Liberal Association - L.; New Democratic Party, Sask. Section - N.D.P.; The Progressive Conservative Party of Saskatchewan - P.C.; Independence Party of Saskatchewan (W.C.C.) - Independence (W.C.C.).

Plebiscites

On 18 June 1991, *The Referendum and Plebiscite Act* (S.S. 1990-91 c.R.-8.01) was passed in the Saskatchewan Legislature. This Act, proclaimed in force on 10 September 1991, is the first Saskatchewan Statute of general application respecting referendums and plebiscites.

Pursuant to Section 6 of *The Referendum and Plebiscite Act*, an Order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council was passed directing the issue of a Writ of Plebiscite. The Saskatchewan electorate was afforded the opportunity to express public opinion in conjunction with the 1991 general election on the following three provincial plebiscite questions:

Question #1

Should the government of Saskatchewan be required to introduce balanced budget legislation?

Question #2

Should the people of Saskatchewan approve, by referendum or plebiscite any proposed changes to the Canadian Constitution?

Question #3

Abortions are legally performed in some Saskatchewan hospitals. Should the government of Saskatchewan pay for abortion procedures?

Official results of the addition of votes for the above stated questions are contained in Part I, Appendix VII of this Report (Vote Summary by Constituency - Plebiscites).
