Background

Central to the legitimacy of representative government is the integrity of the electoral system. Public confidence in the institution of government rests directly on the capacity of the electoral system to perform efficiently, reliably, impartially and in a timely manner. Pursuant to these objectives, *The Election Act*, 1996 (the "Act") contains financial reporting provisions to ensure registered political parties and candidates achieve the transparency goals inherent in the Act. Of particular emphasis was the objective of heightened financial disclosure to enhance public confidence and political stakeholder accountability.

Preliminary Remarks

The Report of the Chief Electoral Officer - Volume II - Campaign Contributions and Expenditures - Twenty-Sixth Provincial General Election, November 7, 2007 complements the Report of the Chief Electoral Officer - Volume I - Statement of Votes - Twenty-Sixth Provincial General Election, November 7, 2007 which was tabled by the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly on September 8, 2008 and the Report of the Chief Electoral Officer - Volume III - Recommendations for Change to *The Election Act*, 1996 - Twenty-Sixth Provincial General Election, November 7, 2007 (Volume III) tabled on April 30, 2009.

The Statement of Votes provides an overview of election administration and encapsulates the official voting results by polling division for the Province's fifty-eight constituencies. "Volume III" starts a new tradition that in the twelve to eighteen months following a general election any recommendations arriving out of the general election, as well as previous recommendations from Annual Reports that have not yet been acted upon, are now included in **Volume III - Recommendations for Changes to** *The Election Act*, 1996. This specific report adds many new recommendations as well as the review or update of recommendations from the last three Annual Reports.

In Volume II the reporting of Campaign Contributions and Expenditures depicts election financial activities of registered political parties and of candidates. More specifically, Volume II sets out the amounts paid to chief official agents and business managers in respect of each registered political party and candidate, pursuant to section 264 and 265 of the Act. Also included in this Volume is summary data for election administration related expenditures of Elections Saskatchewan.

Election Expense Limits

Election campaign activities of registered political parties and candidates are subject to certain expense limitations under the Act. With respect to spending, election expense limitations are imposed on the amounts that can lawfully be incurred by a party or candidate. A second limit regulates the reimbursement entitlement of a qualifying party or candidate (and reimbursement of auditor accounts).

Expense limits are based on factors specific to which the expenses pertain (i.e., general election or byelection), on whether an election is held in a northern or southern constituency ("southern constituency"



includes all constituencies with the exception of Athabasca or Cumberland) and on an established formula, adjusted each calendar year. Expense limit information is available in The Saskatchewan Gazette or at Elections Saskatchewan upon request.

Registered Political Party and Candidate Financial Reporting

In accordance with section 251 of the Act, audited Registered Political Party's Return of Election Expenses, Form E-524, were required to be filed with the Chief Electoral Officer within six months after polling day (May 8, 2008). Under section 261 of the Act, candidates were required to file an audited Candidate's Return of Election Expenses, Form E-412, with their constituency returning officer, for subsequent forwarding to the Chief Electoral Officer, within three months after polling day (February 8, 2008). Pursuant to the Act, within thirty days of receipt, the Province's constituency returning officers publish, in prescribed form, a summary of all returns respecting candidate election expenses.

Candidate returns were receipted within the specified filing deadline for all but six candidates. Of these, five were received after the deadline, namely the returns for the New Democratic Party, Sask Section candidates in the Estevan, Prince Albert Carlton and Prince Albert Northcote constituencies; and the Saskatchewan Party candidates in the Regina Elphinstone Centre and Regina Walsh Acres constituencies. The candidate return for the Saskatchewan Liberal Association candidate in Regina Wascana Plains has not been filed.

In addition the candidate return from the Saskatchewan Liberal Association from the Meadow Lake constituency and the Western Independence Party of Saskatchewan (W.I.P.) for the Cutknife-Turtleford constituency were not audited.

Additional documentation requests were refused in seven cases:

- One Green Party candidate return;
- Four Saskatchewan Liberal Association candidate returns and;
- Two Saskatchewan Party candidate returns.

In the drafting of Volume III, tabled on April 30, 2009, a change is recommended that would provide greater flexibility around the granting of extensions for the filing of candidate expense returns. This may alleviate the potentially harsh consequences of the current legislation.

i) Registered Political Parties

The November 7, 2007 election acknowledged eight political parties for the purpose of fielding candidates. To maintain party registration, registered political parties must endorse at least two candidates in a general election pursuant to clause 227(1)(b) of the Act. Only seven registered political parties fielded two or more candidates for the Twenty-Sixth General Election. The Saskatchewan Democratic Action Party chose not to file candidates for this election and on October 22, 2007, the day set for the close of nominations, applied for voluntary deregistration of the party. Appendix I of this Volume contains a listing of the names and



abbreviations of the Province's political parties, their respective leaders and chief official agents, as recognized in the Register of Political Parties maintained pursuant to section 231 of the Act.¹

A registered political party that endorsed candidates who obtained in the aggregate not less than 15% of the valid votes cast in the election and whose chief official agent filed a Registered Political Party's Return of Election Expenses, pursuant to section 264 of the Act, was entitled to receive a reimbursement of a portion of its election expenses from the Province's General Revenue Fund. Under section 243 of the Act, each registered political party was entitled to spend \$834,650.00 during the campaign. The amount reimbursed to a qualifying party was one half of its election expenses, or the maximum amount of \$417,325.00.

The Act is specific with respect to payment of reimbursement of eligible election expenses. As such, following receipt of an audited return, the Chief Electoral Officer conducts a preliminary review and thereafter forwards an interim payment of 75% of allowable election expenses claimed. Upon completion of a detailed compliance review, a final payment of 25% of the total amount of eligible election expense is paid.

Election expense returns for five registered political parties were received on time. The election expense returns for the Saskatchewan Marijuana Party and the Western Independence Party were subsequently received. The corrected election expense returns for the Green Party of Saskatchewan were recently received and have been reviewed.

Appendix III sets out a summary of eligible expenses incurred by the seven registered political parties and the amounts paid with respect to the parties who qualified for reimbursement. Contributions made to political parties are not listed in the Registered Political Party's Return of Election Expenses, but are set out in each Registered Political Party's Fiscal Period Return, Form E-521, filed in accordance with section 250 of the Act. Comparative summary data for election expenses incurred by registered political parties in 2007 and eight preceding general elections is contained in Appendix V.

(ii) Candidates

At the close of nomination, 241 candidates had been nominated for the 2007 election: 48 Green Party, 59 New Democratic Party (the nominated candidate for the party in the constituency of Swift Current withdrew before the close of nominations and was replaced by a new candidate), 5 Progressive Conservative Party, 58 Saskatchewan Liberal Association, 58 Saskatchewan Party (subsequent to the close of nominations, the candidate in Regina Walsh Acres withdrew and could not be replaced), 5 Saskatchewan Marijuana Party, and 8 Western Independence Party.

Under section 236 of the Act, each candidate was required to appoint a business manager whose responsibility was to report the candidate's receipt of contributions and campaign expenses. Each

candidate was also required to appoint an auditor, pursuant to section 238 of the Act. A list of the names, addresses and occupations of the candidates nominated, together with the names and addresses of their respective business managers can be found in Appendix II of this Volume.

Candidates were limited to the amount of money that each could spend in their respective campaigns, pursuant to section 252 of the Act. A candidate in the 56 southern constituencies was entitled to spend (a) the sum of \$48,413.00 or (b) a sum obtained by multiplying the number of voters in the constituency by \$3.23, whichever sum was larger. The limit for each candidate who ran in either of the northern constituencies of Athabasca or Cumberland was (a) the sum of \$64,550.00 or (b) a sum obtained by multiplying the number of names on the voters' list in the constituency by \$6.44 whichever sum was larger.

A candidate that obtained not less than 15% of the total number of valid votes cast in the constituency in which they were a candidate and whose business manager filed with the constituency returning officer a Candidate's Return of Election Expenses, pursuant to section 265 of the Act, was entitled to a reimbursement of a portion of their election expenses from the General Revenue Fund. The amount reimbursed to a qualifying candidate was an amount equal to 60% of the candidate's election expenses to a maximum of \$29,047.80, or in the case of the two northern constituencies Athabasca and Cumberland, reimbursement of election expenses to a maximum of \$38,730.00.

For the November 7, 2007 election, there were 116 candidates who qualified for reimbursement receiving in the aggregate \$2,417,314.56. In accordance with section 265 of the Act, reimbursements were paid by installment: 75% being released following preliminary review by the Chief Electoral Officer with the remaining 25% forwarded following conduct of a detailed compliance review.

On February 13, 2009, the Office, pursuant to section 262 of the Act, published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette*, Vol. 105, No. 7 a summary of candidate contributions received and expenses incurred in the course of the general election, as well as the amounts paid in respect of each candidate who qualified for reimbursement. Such contributions, expenditures and reimbursements are reported in Appendix IV.

A summary of total contributions received, expenses incurred and reimbursements paid on behalf of independent candidates and of candidates of each of the registered political parties is set out in Appendix VII. For comparative purposes, the same data is provided for the 2003, 1999, 1995, 1991, 1986, 1982, 1978 and 1975 general elections.

Finally, Appendix VI of this Volume contains a summary by political party of candidates nominated, numbers of candidates in respect of whom returns were filed and numbers of candidates reimbursed in the 2007 and eight preceding general elections.



Auditors

The reporting requirements and the responsibility assumed through consenting to appointment as auditor of a registered political party² or candidate includes reporting in writing to the chief official agent or business manager on the respective election expenses return prepared on behalf of the party or individual candidate.

The auditor must employ generally accepted accounting principles and generally accepted auditing standards when conducting review of spending and financial records of a party or candidate. Auditors' duties extend to thorough examination of the accounting records of a party or of a candidate permitting him or her to reach an opinion as to whether the return examined presents fairly the transactions contained in the accounting records on which the return is based. It is compulsory that the party's chief official agent or candidate's business manager provide the information and explanations necessary to facilitate preparation of the auditor's report. In instances where the auditor has reason to believe or is suspicious that proper accounting records were not kept by the party or candidate the auditor must report same.

An auditor's account of a registered political party or candidate is reimbursable regardless of whether the party/candidate qualifies for reimbursement. Pursuant to subsections 267(3) and (6) of the Act, the maximum reimbursement for auditing services rendered in respect of preparation of a report pertaining to registered political party and candidate election expense returns was \$2,477.00 and \$804.00 respectively. See Appendix VIII for aggregate amounts paid for auditor reimbursement – both in respect of registered political parties and candidates.

Orders and Authorizations of the Chief Electoral Officer

The Chief Electoral Officer may make exceptions to the Act's financial reporting provisions for election purposes for both registered political parties and candidates. In such instances, the Act under subsection 286(1), mandates that the Chief Electoral Officer report on the situation and events surrounding the order or authorization granted.

Pursuant to subsection 262(7) of the Act, the Chief Electoral Officer granted twenty-two orders for the extension of time to prepare and file the required Candidate's Return of Election Expenses (Form E-412) as follows: Vinessa Currie [1], Harold Johnson [1], Ray Johnson [1], Norbert Kratchmer [1] (Green Party of Saskatchewan); Kim Trew [1], (New Democratic Party, Sask. Section); Rod Haugerud [1], (Saskatchewan Liberal Association); Nathan Holowaty [1], Mike Kereiff [1], Christine King [1], Matt O'Scienny [1], Tom Shapiro [1], (Saskatchewan Marijuana Party); Gwen Beitel [4], Dan Harder [1], Laura Ross [2], Debbie Stevenson [3 - 1 of which was an amended order], (Saskatchewan Party); and Gordon Elias [1], (Western Independence Party of Saskatchewan (W.I.P.)).

² To fulfill registration maintenance requirements under the Act, a registered political party, pursuant to clause 224(1)(f), must provide the name and address of its auditor in its application for registration.



Elections Saskatchewan Expenditures

Elections Saskatchewan incurred election expenditures of \$10,079,622.68 inclusive of administrative and constituency account payments for the 2007 General Election. This expenditure figure represents a total cost per voter of \$16.85 or \$5.04 per voter for administration and \$11.81 per voter for constituency expenditure. In addition to the foregoing, Appendix VIII establishes the Chief Electoral Office's election expenditures incurred for provision of central co-ordination and support to constituency returning officers and aggregate costs associated with the conduct of the election in the Province's fifty-eight constituencies. Also summarized in Appendix VIII are total election expenditures for each of the Province's individual constituencies. Should further individual constituency expenditure specifics be required, refer to the Detail of Expenditures *The Election Act, 1996* Provincial Constituencies Fiscal Year 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 to be tabled by the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly within the next month.

Documentation

Candidates' Returns of Election Expenses and the related invoices and receipts may be viewed at the address of the respective constituency returning officer for a period of six months after the return has been filed, or may be viewed on the Elections Saskatchewan website at www.elections.sk.ca. Following the expiration of this period, pursuant to section 262 of the Act, the Chief Electoral Officer holds the returns and the original financial documentation regarding individual candidate election expenses for a further eighteen month period.

Also, pursuant to section 232 of the Act, the Chief Electoral Officer is obliged to hold, in addition to the information contained in the Register of Political Parties, all original financial particulars concerning registered political parties' fiscal period and election expenses documentation for the purposes of public inspection. Such information is available to the public during regular office hours at Elections Saskatchewan and they may also be viewed on the Elections Saskatchewan website at www.elections.sk.ca.

Establishment and Use of Mobile Polls

As per clause 286(1)(b) of The Election Act, 1996 this Report is to summarize the establishment and use of mobile polls during the election. In past elections of recent memory, mobile polls were not established unless there were "special or unusual circumstances", such as floods, fires or other natural disasters. In 2004, the all-party committee on revisions to *The Election Act, 1996* advised the Chief Electoral Officer to adapt the use of the mobile poll for use in private personal care facilities and personal care homes. This was done for the 2007 Provincial General Election and was very well received by residents, family members and the administration of most personal care facilities and personal care homes. It meant that the residents could vote in their home and that family members or staff of the facility did not have to assist persons to vote several blocks away from the facility particularly in early November when the weather can sometimes be inclement. As a result of this adapted use of mobile polls for the November 7, 2007 Provincial General Election, a number of recommendations were made in Volume III, which was tabled in the Legislative Assembly on April 30, 2009.



In order to comply with clause 286(1)(b) of The Election Act, 1996 it is the duty of the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer to report that one hundred and seven mobile polls were established for the November 7, 2007 Provincial General Election. See Appendix IX for a constituency by constituency summary of the mobile polls established.

The names and addresses of the constituency returning officers are set out in Appendix X of this Volume.
