# Report of the Chief Electoral Officer

(Part I)

## Official Report

---

The Twenty-Second Saskatchewan Legislature was dissolved on Tuesday, the 23rd day of May, 1995, by the Honourable J.E.N. Wiebe, Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 3 of *The Legislative Assembly and Executive Council Act*. On the same day an Order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council was passed pursuant to Section 4 of *The Election Act* directing the Chief Electoral Officer to issue a Writ of Election to each of 58 returning officers whose names and respective constituencies are set out in Part I, Appendix I of this Report.

The boundaries of the provincial constituencies were as enacted in 1994 under *The Representation Act, 1994 (S.S. 1994, c.R-20.2)*, as recommended by the Constituency Boundaries Commission, 1993, established under *The Constituency Boundaries Act, 1993*. *The Constituency Boundaries Act, 1993*, mandated that 58 constituencies should be proposed by the Commission, with 2 northern constituencies to be created within an area defined in the Act, and with the 56 southern constituencies to be created of equal voter size in the remaining area of the province. This resulted in a reduction of 8 constituencies from the total of 66 constituencies represented in the Assembly prior to the dissolution of the Legislature in 1995. Part II, Appendix VII of this Report contains an illustration of the constituency boundaries pursuant to the above-mentioned Acts.

At the time of the general election there were 5 political parties registered in the Register of Political Parties kept by the Chief Electoral Officer pursuant to Section 203.1 of *The Election Act*:

Saskatchewan Liberal Association  
New Democratic Party, Sask. Section  
The Progressive Conservative Party of Saskatchewan  
Natural Law Party of Saskatchewan  
United Aboriginal Peoples Party

The nomination of candidates took place on Monday, the 5th day of June, 1995. By close of nominations at 2:00 p.m., 178 candidates had been nominated; 58 Liberal, 58 New Democrats, 58 Progressive Conservatives, and 4 United Aboriginal Peoples. Part II, Appendix III of this Report contains a list of the names, addresses and occupations of the candidates nominated together with the names and addresses of their respective business manager. No candidate withdrew from the election and no candidate was elected by acclamation.

On the 6th day of June, 1995, pursuant to Section 203.1(7)(b), following the close of nominations, the Chief Electoral Officer deleted the Natural Law Party of Saskatchewan and the United Aboriginal Peoples Party from the register of political parties because neither party had nominated at least 10 candidates throughout the province. The 4 candidates endorsed by the United Aboriginal Peoples Party were thereafter designated "Independent" candidates.

An enumeration of eligible electors was conducted in each of the 2,701 polling divisions in the province between May 23rd, 1995, and June 1st, 1995, and on Court of Revision, June 17th, 1995. There were 636,227 names appearing on the revised voters' lists.

Advance polling stations were established in one or more places in each constituency and voting was conducted at each of the advance polls on the 14th, 15th, 16th, 17th, and 19th days of June, 1995. There were 155 advance polling stations throughout the province.

Special polling stations were established in 83 hospitals for the benefit of patients receiving care in such institutions and in 4 correctional facilities for the benefit of prisoners held in remand.

Physically incapacitated voters who were unable to go in person to either a regular or advance polling station were entitled to vote by mail-in ballot.

Regular polling stations were open between 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. C.S.T. on the 21st day of June, 1995. Unofficial results on the evening of the 21st day of June, 1995, showed 42 New Democrats, 11 Liberals and 5 Progressive Conservatives elected.


On the 3rd day of July, 1995, returning officers made an addition of votes cast by voters at the regular and advance polling stations and the majority of returning officers counted ballots cast by patients at hospitals, prisoners in remand and physically incapacitated voters who voted by mail-in ballot. No candidate or representative of a candidate was present at the final addition in the constituencies of Arm River, Last Mountain-Touchwood, Meadow Lake, Prince Albert Northcote and Regina Coronation Park and, in accordance with Section 97(2) of *The Election Act*, returning officers in those constituencies did not count ballots cast by patients at hospitals and by prisoners held in remand. Official results of the addition of votes are set out in respect of each constituency in Part I, Appendix III of this Report.

On the 3rd day of October, 1995, each of 58 returning officers made a return to the Writ of Election that was issued to them.

The Chief Electoral Officer published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette* (Vol. 91, No. 31) notice of the receipt of the returns and the names of the candidates elected to the Legislature. The names of the candidates elected are shown in Part I, Appendix II of this Report.

Deposits were forfeited by 68 candidates; 18 Liberals, 1 New Democrat, 45 Progressive Conservatives, and 4 Independents.

In the Appendices of this Report the names of registered political parties that fielded candidates at the election have been abbreviated as follows: Saskatchewan Liberal Association - L.; New Democratic Party, Sask. Section - N.D.P.; The Progressive Conservative Party of Saskatchewan - P.C.




## Constituency of Estevan
