Saskatoon Fairview By-Election Communique for Chief Official Agents

We're one week into the Saskatoon Fairview by-election and, as all of you will have no doubt heard, Elections Saskatchewan will now begin preparing for another by-election due to the resignation of Mr. Bill Boyd, MLA for Kindersley. Given the announced resignation date of September 1, 2017, that by-election will need to be held before March 1, 2018. I will provide more information on that event as it becomes available.
