

Right of Access Candidates and Authorized Representatives

Notice To Building Owners and Property Managers

Please be advised that during provincial elections, section 36.11 of *The Condominium Property Act, 1993* and section 46 of *The Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* require that candidates or authorized representatives be granted access at reasonable times to units and to the common areas of multiple-residence buildings for the purpose of canvassing and distributing election materials.

Section 283.1(1) of *The Election Act, 1996* requires that Elections Saskatchewan provide confirmation of this right to access to any third party upon request.

During the campaign period for a provincial election, buildings are required to provide reasonable access to a candidate, or an authorized agent or representative of a candidate.

Before entering a condominium unit or condominium common space, a candidate or a candidate representative may be required:

- (1) To provide his or her name and address; and
- (2) In the case of a candidate representative, to produce the candidate's written authorization that appoints the representative to act on the candidate's behalf.
