Whereby any information to be filed with the Chief Electoral Officer following selection of a potential candidate by a constituency association of a registered political party becomes known to that party or is altered, the registered political party shall, by instrument in writing (this form) signed by the leader, notify the Chief Electoral Officer of the designation of any such candidate and any subsequent replacement thereof. This form must be filed in conjunction with the written notice by the candidate of the appointment and consent of the Business Manager and of the Auditor having been given authority to act in those capacities (s. 236 and s. 238).
