## **NOTICE:**

Where any person whose name is recorded in the Register of the Chief Electoral Officer ceases to act as Chief Official Agent of a registered political party, the leader of the party shall appoint a new Chief Official Agent (this form) and file Form E-513 within 30 days to notify the Chief Electoral Officer of the alteration pursuant to section 226 of *The Election Act*, 1996.
